Comments:

Sewage is backing up in the basement. There is standing wastewater, fecal matter and toilet paper in the far side of the basement, and soda crates have been placed to allow walk through the sewage backup area to access far side. There is a severe sewage odor. This appears to be a chronic condition due to the amount of sewage accumulation in the basement. Turned water on in the handsink and three bowl sink to verify that the leak was sewage and saw active sewage leakage is occurring.

Facility is ordered closed. Entire facility must be cleaned and sanitized and sewage backup must be repaired before facility can reopen.
