 -Droppings, urine, chewed food and product packaging found on top of popcorn boxes and bags. Discarded

Food Code Section(s): 301

Corrective Action: Discard/remove food that is not in sound condition or not from an approved source.

Corrective Action: Monitor food daily for pest activity

Violation: 19 Pest Management

Comments: *HIGH RISK***

Activity found in the following areas:

- Door mat shelf: Bedding, chewed drywall, urine, and too many droppings to count found under shelf, and to lesser degree under all shelves leading from there to refrigerators.
- Stock room: significant accumulation of droppings, too many to count, found around drywall area that houses electrical boxes, and along floor and bottom shelves from drywall area to door into retail area of store.
- Pet food area: One bag of food chewed on rolling cart, small number of droppings found under shelves and around exit door, urine and too many droppings to count found on second shelf from top with cat food and bowls.
- Food aisles: droppings found on/under some of the remaining snacks in chip aisle, along with some chewed product packaging.
- Employee break room: Droppings, urine, gnawed product packaging found in lockers. Strong odor present in break room of droppings and urine.
- One dead mouse found on trap under toilet paper shelf.
- Gap present at floor/wall juncture in left rear corner of store, in the same condition as noted on last inspection.

Food Code Section(s): 319

Corrective Action: Eliminate pests by approved methods

Corrective Action: Eliminate harborage area, food sources, and entry sites

Corrective Action: Clean and maintain

Corrective Action: Remove rodent droppings

Corrective Action: Check all areas of store thoroughly for activity on a rotating daily basis throughout the week.
