 - Seven 50-Lb bags of seasoned cheddar cheese found gnawed by rodents. A few bags contained rodent droppings.

Food Code Section(s): 331
Corrective Action: Discard/remove food that is not in sound condition or not from an approved source.

Comments: *MEDIUM RISK**
 - Could not locate a grease interceptor. If facility fails to locate one, grease interceptor must be installed by 12.01.2025.

Violation: 19 Pest Management
Comments: *HIGH RISK***
 - Live mouse found behind the walk-in cooler.

 LOW RISK
 - Dead mouse found on glue board in the upstairs tin room.
 - Few rodent droppings remain under the ramp and under the water meter.
 - Some holes remain under the three compartment sink.

 Facility under new contract with a pest control company and significant progress has been made, however adulterated food was still present during today's inspection.

Food Code Section(s): 317
Corrective Action: Clean and maintain
Corrective Action: Remove rodent droppings
Corrective Action: Provide tight-fitting door, screen, or controlled air curtain to prevent pest entry.
Corrective Action: - Continue with frequent treatments
 - Move all food and non-food items two (2) feet away from the wall to ensure pest control operator has access to all areas of the facility and to ensure cleaning and disinfecting can take place.

Violation: 29 Lighting
Comments: *LOW RISK* (REPEAT VIOLATION)
 - Insufficient lighting on first and second floor storage areas.

Food Code Section(s): 314
Corrective Action: Provide at least 50 foot-candles of light in food handling areas and areas where food worker safety is a factor.
