Facility now receiving bi-weekly visits from Pest Control Technician.

Rodent nest present in basement on junction box above dry storage shelving.

Old rodent droppings present in facility along the perimeter of the first floor.
Old rodent droppings present in the basement at the landing of the basement stairs, along the basement perimeter, and in the furnace room.

Light visible beneath rear exterior basement door. Door sweep purchased but not installed.
REPEAT VIOLATION

Excess clutter remains throughout the basement, impeding ability to monitor for new pest activity and clean.

Corrective Action: Eliminate harborage area, food sources, and entry sites

Corrective Action: Remove rodent droppings

Violation: 23 Contamination Prevention - Food, Utensils and Equipment

Many cases Maggi noodles observed in the basement stored on the ground.

Corrective Action: Store food, utensils, single-use and single-service articles at least 6 inches off of the floor

No mop sink present in facility. (Facility is carpeted).

Excessive clutter remains present throughout basement.

Food Code Section(s): 315

Corrective Action: Provide approved mop service sink

Corrective Action: Remove miscellaneous items

Corrective Action: Remove all non-essential items from facility that are not used daily.
